### **1. APOLOGIES**

There were no apologies for absence.

### **2. PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES**

The Chair introduced the Sub-Committee and its Clerk.

The Clerk to the Sub-Committee on behalf of the Head of Legal, Scrutiny and Democratic Services explained the procedures to be followed by the Sub-committee.

### **3. APPLICATION TO REVIEW A PREMISES LICENCE – KINGS HEAD, MEIFOD**

**Applicant for review:** Mr A. & Mrs E. Gwalchmai

**Licence holder:** Mr R F Thomas, represented by Mr B.K. Holland of Messrs Aaron and Partners, Chester.

The Licensing Officer presented the licensing authority's position as outlined in the report [copy filed with the signed minutes].

Mr A. Gwalchmai appearing on behalf of himself and his wife, briefly outlined how his family had been disturbed by noise from the licensed premises especially at weekends during the summer. He explained how the family had to keep windows shut, even during hot summer nights in order to reduce the noise from the Kings Head. He explained that their complaints were set out in their application for review.

The licence holder's representative noted that the village police officer had not personally received any complaints concerning the premises but some had been recorded on the Police National Computer which were received at another station and the police officer present confirmed that to be the case. There were no representations from any of the relevant authorities.

All parties confirmed that they had been able to make their representations.

The Sub-Committee withdrew to consider, in private, the application and the evidence they had heard, with the support of the Clerk.

On their return the Chair announced their decision. In reaching the decision members took into account the relevant written and verbal representations.

**RESOLVED that no action to be taken in respect of a review of the premises licence for the Kings Head, Meifod.**

The Clerk to the Sub-Committee advised the applicant and the local resident that she would confirm the decision in writing and reminded them of their right to appeal.
