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REPORT FOR: Decision

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1. **Purpose**

1.1 This report makes a minor amendment to the budget proposed to Council on the 28th February 2020.

2. **Proposal**

2.1 That £152,000 additional Council Tax is included in the revenue budget for 2020-21 to account for an increased level of collection in Council Tax premiums for 2<sup>nd</sup> homes and empty properties.

2.2 That the Council Tax increase in 2020-21 will be 4.8%, which will generate £152,000 less income than the previously proposed 5% increase. Recommendation 2 of the original budget proposal is amended accordingly

3. **Resource Implications and Section 151 Officer Opinion**

3.1 The projected outturn for 2019-20 includes a considerable surplus on the level of Council Tax collected, adjustments have been made to the 2020-21 Council Tax base to include more properties which attract a premium in the calculation. Performance this year cannot be guaranteed for future years, as the classification of properties can change at anytime, however, the level of adjustment proposed does not significantly change the level of risk in this regard.

3.2 The level of change proposed by the amendment does not change the Section 151 Officers opinion to that expressed in the original report, in that the estimates used in the budget proposal for 2020-21 are adequately robust but significant risk remains. Based on the assessment of reserves the overall level is adequate but remains at the lower end of acceptability given the scale of savings required over the medium term.

4. **Legal Implications**

4.1 The Solicitor to the Council (Monitoring Officer) notes the amendments to the budget proposal.
