REPORT FOR: DECISION

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Mr Takhar and Mr Rakar submitted an application for a full variation of the premise licence for the Punchbowl at the end of August 2018. The applicants requested opening hours of 11.00am until 03.30am Monday to Sunday, with alcohol sales until 03.00. There was also an application for both live and recorded music indoors and outdoors; 01.00am for live music indoors and outdoors and recorded music indoors and outdoors until 02.00. (see table below in 2.2 for full breakdown of application).

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 A location plan for the premises is attached as Annex A to this report.
- 2.2 The applicant has requested the following hours. For ease of use, I have included a table showing both existing hours and the new application hours.

- 2.3 A copy of the premises licence application, made under the Licensing Act 2003, is attached at **Annex B**.
- 2.4 In accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 procedure, the Applicant has sent copies of the application to the Responsible Authorities for consultation, and has advertised the application to bring it to the attention of any Interested Parties. The Council also published the application on its website throughout the 28 day consultation period.
- 2.5 The new owners took over the Premise at the end of July 2018; following a complaint from a local resident, Licensing had to send a Written Warning to the Licence Holders for having regulated entertainment when they did not have a licence to do so. (letter sent 21st August Annex C)

3. REPRESENTATIONS

3.1 Responsible Authorities

During the Consultation period, Environmental Health Officer, Daniel Stykuc met with the applicant and it was agreed that the times would be amended to –

- Live music (indoors) 00.00 (midnight)
- Live music (outdoors) 00.00 (midnight)
- Recorded Music (indoors) 02.00am
- Recorded Music (outdoors) 00.00 (midnight)

Also, this Condition would be added to the Licence –

"All windows and doors (except for access) will be closed after 00.00 hours (midnight)"

The applicant accepted these new times and the Condition and based on these new times, the Officer had no further Representations to make.

Therefore, please note new times now being applied for-

- Live music (indoors) 00.00 (midnight)
- Live music (outdoors) 00.00 (midnight)
- Recorded Music (indoors) 2am
- Recorded Music (outdoors) 00.00 (midnight)

3.2 Interested Parties

Four written objections have been received from local residents or their Representatives, making representations against the application, copies of which can be found at **Annex D**. The objections made within these letters make reference to potential noise and disturbance issues from the premises, in particular the outdoor music element.

4. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

4.1 Rod Bowen, Police Licensing Officer (following a meeting with the applicant and confirmation of Daniel Stykuc's amended time allowances) requested that a further two Conditions were placed on the Licence.

Additional Operational Conditions will be:

- 1. A proof of age policy applying the principles of Challenge 25 shall operate at the Premises. Details of staff training around this principle together with details of refusals of sales due to this policy shall be recorded in an incident book that shall be made available on request for inspection by any Police Officer, Licensing Officer and Trading Standards Officer of the Local Authority.
- 2. At all points of exit from the premises a notice shall be displayed requesting customers to be respectful of the neighbours and to leave the premises quietly and in a manner that does not disturb the neighbours.

5. OPTIONS

- 5.1 In determining the application for a Premises Licence, the Sub-Committee must take such steps as are considered necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives, which are:-
 - (a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
 - (b) public safety;
 - (c) the prevention of public nuisance; and

(d) the protection of children from harm.

The options available in determining this application are:



RE: LICENSING ACT 2003

The Licensing Department is in receipt of a complaint concerning music being played beyond the licensable hours. (up to 00.30 this past weekend). As you are aware, you currently do not have Entertainment on your licence – although steps are being made to vary this licence.

I have met with Pal and I understand that a variation will soon be submitted to the Licensing Authority to include Entertainment (namely live and recorded music) onto the Licence. Currently, the only times you are currently permitted to play music is between 8am and 11pm. (this is permitted under the Live Music Act). To play music any later, you will need to vary your premise licence.

Therefore, please note that <u>NO MUSIC (either live or recorded) can be played any later than 11pm on any evening</u>, until your Licence has been granted to vary it to include entertainment. (please note there is a 28 day consultation period once this application is put in and there may be objections also, which could extend this time further).

I believe that the person who has complained (anonymously to us) is intending to contact the Noise Team in Environmental Health, to file a complaint with them regarding the recent 'excessive' noise from the pub, past it's permitted hours.

Therefore, please take this letter as a Warning, that any future breaches of your licence may result in more formal action being taken by this Department.

We write in respect of the above application to vary the licence, with a concern in particular of potential noise nuisance with Live and Recorded Music and provision of Late-Night Refreshments. It is the Outdoor element of these that we are concerned about.

We have lived next to the Punch Bowl for 22 years and have never had any significant issues. Our bedroom is immediately by the adjoining fence so we do hear conversation when people are using the smoking area along with the music played via the outdoor speaker. In 2014 when it was looking like the pub would close we wrote indicating that we supported the village in maintaining the facility.

For the first 6 weeks of the new licensees tenure, recorded music was played until around 0020 every Friday and Saturday. On 11 August at 1640 recorded music was played outside so loud that even with our doors and windows closed we could not hear the television in our lounge.

I visited the pub asking for them to turn the music down to a reasonable level. A discussion was had, I said I knew they had a business to run and accepted some noise was inevitable. Following that discussion, the music was turned down but again was played until around 0020.

Music has been played until around 0020 on 19 August, 31 August and until 2345 on 1 September.

We therefore request that the Outdoor element of the variation is not granted.

Should the decision be taken to grant some of the variation we would request that the Outdoor element be no later than:

Live Music Monday to Sunday

2300

Recorded Music

Monday to Sunday

2300

Provision of Late Night Refreshments

Monday to Sunday

2300

Plays, Films, Performance of Dance

Monday to Sunday

2300

Furthermore, that the application for variation for the supply of Alcohol is not granted as this would inevitably involve patrons using the smoking area potentially causing noise which as described above we can hear from our bedroom.

We believe that the requested timings are realistic and reasonable for a licenced premise situated in very close proximity to residential properties to reduce any potential noise disturbance.
