REPORT FOR: Decision

1. **Summary**

- 1.1 As part of its 21st C Schools Programme, the authority has three projects which have been affected by the collapse of Dawnus Construction Ltd. (Dawnus) Welshpool CiW Primary School, Ysgol Gymraeg y Trallwng and Ysgol Bro Hyddgen. Dawnus had been appointed as the main contractor for these three projects.
- 1.2 Dawnus was placed into administration in March 2019 with the immediate impact being on Welshpool CiW Primary School, which was approximately 50% complete at the time, with an intended opening date of September 2019. The other two projects were at RIBA Stage 4 and construction had not yet started.
- 1.3 The purpose of this report is to gain approval for the Council to secure the continued service of the main architectural design consultants and main mechanical and engineering consultants that were originally commissioned by Dawnus in order to provide continued design consultancy support for the completion of Welshpool CiW Primary School. This report relates only to Welshpool CiW Primary School any decisions required for Ysgol Gynradd y Trallwng and Ysgol Bro Hyddgen projects will be subject to separate reports at the appropriate time.

2. Proposal

2.1 The Welshpool CiW Primary School project is funded as part of Band A of the 21st C Schools Programme. The Programme is split into two funding rounds - Band A runs from 2014 to 2019, and Band B from 2019 – 2024/5. The approved funding envelope for Band A is £79m and Band B is £113m. The programme is funded in partnership between the Council and Welsh Government.

- 2.2 The budget for the Welshpool CiW Primary School project is £11.5m, with 50% of the funding being provided by the Council and the remainder from the Welsh Government. The design is for a 240 place timber-framed 'PassivHaus' accredited school 'PassivHaus' is a quality assurance system backed by a rigorous accreditation process, based on a number of benefits which include minimised energy consumption and bills, and optimised lifecycle costs.
- 2.3 The Council is in the process of re-tendering for a new main contractor to complete the construction of Welshpool CiW Primary School. In addition, there is need to secure the continued service of the main architectural and mechanical/engineering design consultants that were originally commissioned by Dawnus.
- 2.4 Architype were commissioned by Dawnus to provide an architectural design service Architype has strong expertise in designing 'PassivHaus' buildings, including schools. WSP were commissioned by Dawnus to provide mechanical/engineering design service. An integrated approach between both services is required to deliver 'PassivHaus'- accredited schemes.
- 2.5 Officers have engaged with both companies and discussions have been positive. Fee proposals have been received from both to provide design support for the completion of the project:

The fee proposal from WSP for outstanding work up to completion of the project is for £51,319 and includes the following:

- Fees for Costs Associated with Re-Establishing the Contract / Direct appointment with Powys CC and Mobilising the Delivery Team.
- Fees that were remaining to be undertaken under the original Dawnus commission.
- Condition surveys and report on works that have been completed to date.
- Additional fees required to Complete Services / additional site visits / liaison and coordination during remaining project stages.
- Transfer of IPR (Intellectual Property Rights) to Powys County Council

 all design information, held previously under license by Dawnus
 Construction Ltd.

The fee proposal from Architype is for £70,984.31 and includes the following:

- Fees for Costs Associated with Re-Establishing the Contract / Direct Appointment with Powys CC and Mobilising the Delivery Team.
- Fees that were remaining to be undertaken under the original Dawnus commission.

- Additional fees required to Completed Services inclusive of Principal Designer / additional site visits / liaison and coordination during remaining project stages
- Transfer of IPR (Intellectual Property Rights) to Powys County Council, all design information, held previously under license by Dawnus Construction Ltd.
- 2.6 It is proposed that the Council enters into contract directly with both companies via existing Framework Contracts for the amounts stated in paragraph 2.5. The nature of the contract will be as follows:

WSP – South West and Mid Wales Regional Engineering Consultancy Framework National Procurement Service Framework – Direct Call off on NPS-PS-0067-16.

Architype – NEC 3 Professional Services Contract.

2.7 Financial implications

Alongside the proposal to enter into direct contract with Architype and WSP for design services, the authority will be re-tendering for a main contractor to complete the construction. The final implications on the overall project budget will not be known until the project has been successfully re-tendered. There is enough flexibility in Band A of the 21st C Schools Programme to fund any potential increase in costs for this project.

3. Options Considered / Available

- 3.1 It is proposed that the Council enters into contract directly with WSP for the sum of £51,319 and Architype for the sum of £70,984.31 for design services to complete the construction of Welshpool CiW Primary School:
 - WSP to provide remaining mechanical / electrical, civil & structural engineering design service.
 - Architype to provide architectural design service supporting the 'PassivHaus' design / delivery.

4. <u>Preferred Choice and Reasons</u>

4.1 The preferred option is to enter into contract directly with WSP and Architype, as outlined in 3.1.

This will:

 enable the Council to progress with the completion of the construction on the Welshpool CiW Primary School project with an intended opening date of September 2020;

- ensure that the final product is of a high standard and supported by the appropriate design warranties for both the proposed on-going service and design work already undertaken for Dawnus to date;
- ensure that the school can continue to be designed as a fully-certified 'PassivHaus' school, leading to optimised lifecycle costs and energy efficiency.

The Commercial Services Lead comments that "both Architype and WSP are proposed for direct award due to the extensive design work already undertaken for the schools and to avoid having to rework and redesign all elements. WSP will be appointed under the NPS framework for professional services and similar contracting arrangements put in place with Architype. Commercial Services are satisfied that this will provide the best overall value for money solution for the Council in the circumstances"
