In addition to meetings and activities of the organisations and committees listed above, I have also attended meetings of:

- I have held surgeries in my ward, delivered Focus newsletters to households, attended Police Community Support Officer [PCSO] surgeries to raise local issues and attended consultations that have affected my ward and its residents.
- I have been involved in the preparation and execution of Newtown Food Festival, taken part in a litter pick from Newtown to Penarth Nature Reserve and assisted in the redevelopment of the Cross Building housing the Robert Owen Museum, Reading Room and Town Council.
- I liaised with Council officers regarding the rollout of LED lighting across the ward to

ensure good coverage, requested and saw the installation of four new mixed waste bins, requested and saw a bad drainage problem fixed in Cambrian Gardens, and ensured the recycling rollout in Llanllwchaiarn went smoothly.

- Following concerns raised by residents and liaising with Highways and the police, a series of improvements have been made between Newtown and Llanllwchaiarn in order to reduce traffic speeds, including Slow/Araf warnings, additional roundels, edge of carriageway markings and the carriageway edge built up to enhance safety. Markings have also been refreshed along Cambrian Way to improve visibility.
- I have been working very closely with Council officers, Newtown and Llanllwchaiarn Town Council and local residents to ensure that two areas of land allocated to recreation can be transferred from a receiver to the Town Council so that funding can be raised to site play equipment on them and maintain it into the future.
- I undertook a range of casework on behalf of residents relating to housing, benefits, local environment, transport, planning and other issues.

Penarth ac wedi cynorthwyo gyda'r gwaith o ailddatblygu'r Adeilad ar y Groes lle lleolir Amgueddfa Robert Owen, yr Ystafell Ddarllen a Chyngor y Dref.

- Cysylltais â swyddogion y Cyngor ynghylch y broses o gyflwyno goleuadau LED ar draws y ward i oleuo'r lle yn well, gofynnais am osod pedwar bin gwastraff cymysg newydd a gwnaed hyn. Gwelais broblem ddrwg gyda draenio a gofynnais am iddi gael ei datrys yn Cambrian Gardens, a gofalais fod cyflwyno'r cynllun ailgylchu yn Llanllwchaearn wedi mynd yn esmwyth.
- Yn dilyn pryderon a godwyd gan drigolion ac wrth gysylltu â'r Adran Prifffyrdd a'r heddlu, gwnaed cyfres o welliannau rhwng y Drenewydd a Llanllwchaearn er mwyn lleihau cyflymder y traffig, gan gynnwys gosod rhybuddion Araf / Slow, marciau cylchol ('roundels') ychwanegol, marciau ar ymyl y gerbydlon a chryfhau ymyl y ffordd i wella diogelwch. Gosodwyd marciau newydd hefyd ar hyd Cambrian Way er mwyn gwella gwelededd.
- Rwyf wedi bod yn gweithio'n agos iawn gyda swyddogion y Cyngor, Cyngor Tref Y Drenewydd a Llanllwchaearn a thrigolion lleol er mwyn sicrhau y gallai dwy ardal o dir a ddyrannwyd ar gyfer hamdden gael eu trosglwyddo o ddwylo derbynnydd i Gyngor y Dref fel y gellir codi arian i osod offer chwarae arnynt a'u cynnal yn y dyfodol.
