I have assisted many residents in applications for licences of various sorts.

- d) Trwy fynychu cyfarfodydd mudiadau amrywiol o fewn fy ward.

Rwyf hefyd wedi rhoi cymorth i'm dau Gyngor Cymuned (Aber-miwl gyda Llandysul a Betws Cedewain) drwy fynychu'r rhan fwyaf o gyfarfodydd, gan roi cymorth a chyngor iddynt ac adroddiadau briffio rheolaidd ar faterion perthnasol.
