During the year I helped with parking problems, overhanging boughs from trees, potholes, helped with access to Ward Member's property (having hand rails installed and paths repaired), helping with disabled access in the streets, changing the street lights to LEDs, altering the times for the street lights to be on (where required), reporting fly tipping incidents, attending meetings with Aviva, meetings in the town about various town matters (including the twinning signs and repairs to the streets) the opening of the new Skateboard Park.

Reporting drains needing clearing, reporting storm damage, ordering refuse bins and salt bins (where needed) supporting the Fire Brigade when faced with Closure, attending as

many local functions as I could, regularly walking in the town and speaking to ward members, attending meetings outside the School to discuss slowing down the traffic and parking, arranging parking agreements for groups in Bowling Green Lane Car Park, keeping the Town Council up to date with planning, CAB and other matters received relevant to the Town (including the toilet and grass cutting situation), details of grants and nominations etc, reporting any repairs or matters to Powys which were their liability (including broken seats in the bus stop, recycling bins and pot holes), visiting the School as a governor, attended a visit to a council house to measure up and plan replacement kitchen.
