Section 2: Constituency activity

I held regular joint surgeries with either the M.P. or A.M. at the Liberal Democrat office in Brecon, which is in my ward. I also delivered a regular "Focus" newsletter throughout the ward (1,200 addresses). This had articles of concern to residents and my contact details. I acted as an advocate for residents in planning disputes etc and provided advice to residents in respect of P.C.C. issues such as parking, streetlighting etc.

I attended public meetings in the ward which may impact on my role as Councillor, e.g. Health Board Consultations, Police and Community Together [PACT] meetings, Utility Companies etc. I gave talks to PROBUS and Rotary in Brecon.

I intervened with the Post Office to get a post box reopened, and another replaced.

I requested additional litter bins in areas where dog fouling has been a problem, and the new bins seem to have helped reduce the problem. I discussed on-site with the Portfolio Holder for Highways the on-going difficulties with the Ship Street traffic lights and also

parking problems in the ward. Where needed, I requested streetlights to be placed back on for Anti Social Behaviour reasons. At residents request I arranged for new car parking at Borderers Way to include dedicated disabled parking bays.

Section 3: Learning & Development - after the elections in May 2012 induction sessions were provided during May and June to ensure that Councillors could undertake their roles. Ongoing monthly development is provided.

Induction sessions –Code of Conduct; Safeguarding and Corporate Parenting; Planning Protocol.

Ongoing development - Treasury Management, Information handling and data protection, Estyn update; Performance and project management, Pensions - Hedge Fund management; Members' Annual reports and using Outlook, Pensions – Investment seminar, Powys Change Plan, Making Social Media work for Councillors.

Development as a member of BBNPA - National Parks in Wales, Role of Members, Corporate Governance, Code of Conduct, Planning Protocol, Member/Officer Protocol Role of Chairmen, Social Inclusion.

Section 4: Outside organisations and other activities

I was involved with the twinning of Brecknockshire with Blaubeuren, Germany. Last year, as Town Council Mayor I welcomed a delegation from Blaubeuren to Brecon with a reception at the Guildhall and hosted a farewell dinner at The Castle Hotel on their return. Adran 2: Gweithgaredd Etholaethol

Cynhaliais gymorthfeydd ar y cyd rheolaidd gyda naill ai'r A.S. neu'r A.C. yn swyddfa'r Democratiaid Rhyddfrydol yn Aberhonddu, sydd yn fy ward. Dosbarthais gylchlythyr rheolaidd "Ffocws" drwy'r ward (i 1,200 o gyfeiriadau). Roedd gan hwn erthyglau o bwys i drigolion ac roedd yn cynnwys fy manylion cyswllt. Gweithredais fel eiriolwr i drigolion mewn anghydfodau cynllunio ac ati, a rhoddais gyngor i breswylwyr mewn perthynas â materion CSP fel parcio, goleuadau stryd ac ati.

Mynychais gyfarfodydd cyhoeddus yn y ward a allai effeithio ar fy rôl fel Cynghorydd, e.e. Ymgynghoriadau'r Bwrdd Iechyd, cyfarfodydd yr Heddlu a'r Gymuned gyda'i Gilydd (PACT), Cwmniau Cyfleustodau ac ati. Rhoddais sgysiau i PROBUS a'r Clwb Rotari yn Aberhonddu.

Ymyrrais gyda Swyddfa'r Post i gael blwch postio wedi'i ailagor, ac un arall wedi'i amnewid.

Gofynnais am finiau sbwriel ychwanegol mewn ardaloedd lle mae baw cŵn wedi bod yn broblem, ac mae'n ymddangos fod y biniau newydd wedi helpu i leihau'r broblem.

Trafodais gyda'r Aelod Portffolio ar gyfer Priffyrdd ar y safle yr anawsterau parhaus gyda'r goleuadau traffig yn Ship Street a hefyd y problemau parcio yn y ward. Lle roedd angen, gofynnais am i oleuadau stryd gael eu rhoi yn ôl am resymau yn ymwneud ag Ymddygiad Gwrthgymdeithasol. Ar gais trigolion trefnais i le parcio ceir newydd yn Borderers Way gynnwys manau parcio penodedig i'r anabl.
