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**1. Summary**

- 1.1 The Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015 requires Powys Public Service Board (Powys PSB) partners to jointly prepare and publish a well-being plan.
- 1.2 A report, prepared by the PSB, requesting formal approval and adoption is attached as Appendix A and contains details of how the plan was developed and how its delivery will be developed.
- 1.3 The Powys Public Service Board (PSB) has prepared Towards 2040, the Powys Well-being Plan (See Appendix B), in accordance with the terms of the Well-being of Future Generations Act.
- 1.4 This report is for the purpose of Powys County Council formally receiving and approving Towards 2040 in order for it to be published before 3rd May 2018.
- 1.5 The Cabinet's Vision 2025 is closely aligned to the Towards 2040 plan and outcomes.
- 1.6 The following members of the PSB will be presenting the final well-being plan to their respective Board, or delegated committee, for approval and adoption.

- 2.1 It is proposed that the Council, as a statutory member of the Powys PSB, approve and adopt Towards 2040, the Powys Well-being Plan
