REPORT FOR: Decision

1. **Summary**

1.1 The attached Statement of Reasons at Appendix A sets out the reasons for Powys County Council, with the consent of the Welsh Government, seeking to introduce modifications to the existing on street waiting and loading prohibition Traffic Regulation Order relating to a number of Trunk and County Roads within the town of Welshpool, to facilitate agreed changes to the Welshpool Gyratory System.

2. Proposal

- 2.1 The proposed Order essentially seeks to modify and regulate the type and locations of existing on highway parking spaces and waiting/loading prohibitions at a number of locations within Welshpool to safely accommodate the physical changes to the local highway network within Welshpool forming part of the modifications to the Welshpool Gyratory System.
- 2.2 The proposed Order will also introduce additional waiting prohibitions along certain lengths of Brook Street and the Henfaes Industrial Estate as a result of legitimate safety concerns raised by residents and businesses following the 2016 review of the on highway waiting and loading prohibitions within Welshpool.
- 2.3 The proposed Traffic Regulation Order and accompanying plans are attached at Appendix B.

3. Options Considered / Available

3.1 The modified traffic order is proposed as a result of the public consultation carried out by the Welsh Government between the dates of 10 September and 3 December 2018. Detailed design for the proposed highway network has already been completed and approved. As such there are no other options to be considered with respect to this report at this stage of the project.

4. Preferred Choice and Reasons

4.1 The proposal is the only option to be considered, and is required to implement the required traffic regulations to accommodate the approved highway design.
