**Premises** – Three Tuns, Hay

**Applicant** – Mr David John Lonsdale

Mr Nick Semper, Licensing Consultant with L E Lonsdale, D J Heele and P Neads attended the meeting on behalf of the applicant.

14 written representations from members of the public were received and taken into consideration, none of the objectors attended the hearing.

The Licensing Officer presented the licensing authority's position as outlined in the report [copy filed with the signed minutes]. He advised that the Licensing section was happy with the consultation undertaken by the applicant.

All parties confirmed that they had been able to make their representations.

The Sub-Committee withdrew to consider, in private, the application and the evidence they had heard, with the support of the Clerk.

On their return the Chair announced their decision. In reaching the decision members took into account the relevant written and verbal representations.

<b>RESOLVED</b>	<b>Reason for decision</b>
<b>That the variation to the licence be approved, save for the fact that no live, recorded or amplified music can be played outside the Licensed Premises after 23:00 with the exception of Bank Holiday Weekends, Bank Holidays and the days during the Hay Festival Period.</b>	<b>The panel made this decision in order to promote the four licensing objectives as set out in the Licensing Act 2003.</b>

The Clerk to the Sub-Committee advised that he would confirm the decision in writing and reminded parties of their right to appeal.
