a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 10)

- -A CCTV system is in operation, the coverage of this includes both external cameras and internal cameras covering the area where alcohol is to be stored and sold. Further cameras are planned to be installed to give increased coverage.
- -The licensee is to be responsible for ensuring that there are sufficient competent staff on duty in relation to the sale of alcohol and in order to maintain the licensing objectives.
- -The licensee will ensure that staff undertake appropriate training in relation to the sale of alcohol. Records of this training and any refresher training is to be kept in staff records.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- -Any crime witnessed by a member of staff will be reported to the police.
- -Any CCTV footage or other evidence of crime/disorder will be provided to the police.
- -The BBPA 'Drugs and Pubs Leaflet' is to be used as guidance for on identifying drug use and to implement policies to dissuade the use of drugs on the premises.
- -All goods, including those subject to duty payments, will be purchased from reputable cash and carries and invoices will be made available where required. No alcohol will be purchased by the premises from any other sources.

c) Public safety

- -Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place including suitable fire extinguishers, fire exit signs, smoke detection, and emergency lighting. These are tested annually by qualified contractors and inspected regularly in accordance with fire safety regulations.
- -Where alcohol is not being directly supervised it will be kept in secure, locked storage and access to the keys controlled.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- -A 'quiet after 2200' policy is in place on the site. This is advertised through the use of signage and actively policed by onsite staff.
- -The service of alcohol is to stop 30mins before closing time. This is to allow a 'drinking up period'.

e) The protection of children from harm

- -A 'Challenge 25' scheme will be in operation in accordance with the Retail of Alcohol Standards Group guidance. This will include displaying posters and training staff on what is acceptable as age verification.
- -Under 18's are to be kept under close adult supervision at all times as per the terms and conditions advertised on our website.

 - Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
 - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not








Existing Second Floor Plan Scale: 1:50
