Section 2: Constituency activity

Ongoing from the previous 12-month period, I saw a significant increase in furthering tenants' concerns over the time taken in addressing housing repairs and the length of time in re-letting 'Voids'. The in-house grounds' maintenance contract saw a significant number of constituents' appreciation of the service.

My involvement with voluntary bodies is very rewarding, particularly in providing services for the elderly, those with disability difficulties and citizens with learning difficulties.

I also spent time in working for and promoting a bus/train transport interchange in Machynlleth. With Welsh Government funding, the county council is working on a scheme to present to stakeholders.

Also taking up time, corresponding with the Welsh Government Transport Minister to start on the proposed new Pont ar Dyfi/Dyfi Bridge and associated major works (road over the floodplain, etcetera) has bourn fruit with work having started on the £45 million pound scheme recently.

Whilst understanding why, my constituents have been frustrated with the delay for a start date for the proposed new All-through Ysgol Bro Hyddgen School. However, Machynlleth residents were delighted to see a start being made on the PTHB project (£15 million) to enhance facilities and refurbish the Machynlleth Community Hospital.

Ond ar yr un pryd, deall y rhesymau pan fod fy etholwyr wedi teimlo'n rhwystredig gyda'r oedi am ddyddiad dechrau ysgol bob oed Ysgol Bro Hyddgen.
