Natur a Ni / Nature and Us

In late January NRW jointly with WG will be launching a national conversation with citizens in Wales about the future of the natural environment, and the actions we can all take to safeguard it for the future. The aim is to involve people in a way that builds towards a shared vision for Wales for 2030, 2050, and the pathways to get us there.

We have worked with the Minister for Climate Change, Julie James, on the timing of this campaign to follow on from the COP26 conversations, and the lead up to the Biodiversity COP15.

We have already been working closely with you in Powys on developing the assessments of local well-being. As referred to in our response to the consultation on the Well-being Assessment, we now want to explore how the outputs from the national conversation on the future of the Welsh environment can be woven into longer-term planning through the development of the Well-being Plan.

The note attached, (also sent as part of the recent WG PSB Bulletin), sets out an offer that NRW is making for PSBs to be a part of the national conversation. Our colleagues are on hand to work with the PSB in Powys to take forward these arrangements should you choose to take up the offer.
