

Life as a County Councillor – What to expect over the next few weeks

Following your election today, you need to know what will happen over the next few weeks.

Political Groups

- The following Political Groups have been established in the Council:
 - Welsh Liberal Democrats Group
 - Welsh Conservative Group
 - Welsh Labour Group
 - Independent Group
 - Independent's for Powys Group
 - Plaid Cymru Group
- You may be approached by Group Leaders asking you to join a group.
- If you join a Group you will be allocated a seat on a committee or committees. Information about committees is provided in the document - Committee information – the role of various committees.
- You do not have to join a political group and can decide to remain as 'Non-Affiliated'. The Council will decide on which committees Non-Affiliated members will sit.

The Cabinet

- After the election in May 2022 the Welsh Liberal Democrats and Welsh Labour Group (the two groups who comprise the majority of members of the Council) nominated a councillor as Leader, which was confirmed by Full Council.
- The Leader decided on the number of councillors to form the Cabinet and allocated portfolios to these individuals. Details of the Cabinet are available on the website - [Cabinet](#)

Member Development Induction Programme

Arrangements will be made with you to meet with relevant officers as part of your induction. You will be given access to the recordings of some induction training that has already taken place and you will also be given access to eLearning. Much of this initial training will be mandatory and includes the Members Code of Conduct and training to enable you to sit on various committees.

Further Member Development Sessions will be held on a monthly basis during your term of office, some of which may be Mandatory. You will receive diary invitations to these sessions.

What happens if the public ask me to sort out a problem for them or if they have a complaint?

Members of the public may contact you as soon as you have been elected to sort out a problem or to complain about services.

We have a Member Support Officer, Mel Hardwick and you will be able to contact her for help and support.

Town and community council meetings

Within your ward a number of town and / or community councils may exist. Attending their meetings is one way to make links with your local community, although you do not have to attend these meetings . Such links, however, can help you in communicating issues and developments within the County Council to your local community and also enable them to raise issues and opportunities with you.

Outside Bodies

- You may be invited to attend meetings of organisations within your electoral division as you are the “Local Member”.
- There are a number of other organisations to which the Council makes appointments / nominations. You will be able to put your name forward by means of political groups, when any vacancies occur.

Annual Meetings of Committees will take place during June and July to appoint Chairs and Vice Chairs of:

- Planning, Taxi Licensing and Rights of Way Committee
- Licensing Act 2003 Committee
- Employment and Appeals Committee
- Pensions and Investment Committee
- Governance and Audit Committee

- Nid oes raid i chi ymuno â grŵp gwleidyddol a gallwch benderfynu parhau i fod “heb ymlyniad gwleidyddol”. Bydd y Cyngor yn penderfynu ar ba bwyllgorau y bydd yr aelodau heb ymlyniad gwleidyddol yn eistedd.

Y Cabinet

- Ar ôl yr etholiad ym mis Mai 2022, grwpiau Democratiaid Rhyddfrydol Cymru a Llafur Cymru yw’r ddau grŵp gwleidyddol sy’n cynnwys y mwyafrif o aelodau’r Cyngor) sydd wedi enwebu cynghorydd fel Arweinydd, a gadarnhawyd gan y Cyngor Llawn.
